For all students Entering 9th Grade

Iowa law requires any student entering the 9th Grade provide the school proof of a dental screening. The purpose of this law is to improve the oral health of Iowa's children. For 9th grade students, screenings must occur no earlier than 1 year before enrollment and no later than 4 months after enrollment.

All students entering the 9th grade must have proof of a dental screening. Proof of a dental screening must be provided on the *Certificate of Dental Screening* form provided by the Iowa Department of Public Health (This form is on the Griswold School Website). **The screening must be done by a dentist or dental hygienist.** Your provider should complete the *Certificate of Dental Screening form*, for you to return to the school office. **This is a requirement for the 2018-2019 school year**
